Post Commander's Message

Post 40 Family,

Happy New Year!! This year has quickly put 2021 in our rear-view mirrors. We accomplished many things in 2021, and I as your Post Commander am excited to see what we as a Post will do in 2022.

During this past November and December Post 40 along with the SAL and the AUX prepared and provided over 300 hot meals to the Anne Arundel County Crisis Response Unit to feed AAC residents/families in need for Thanksgiving and Christmas.

Post 40 also hosted a free Children's Christmas Party "Pancakes with Santa". We registered 65 families, provided free breakfast and free gifts to the children who registered to attend. DJ Dan Calhoun provided free pictures of the children with Santa to each family. This was an amazing event and we were able to provide over 50 sets of pajamas to Casey Cares on behalf of all the families who attended. It was a great day for Post 40 and the children/families of our community. We hope to make next year's event even bigger to allow more families to attend.

You are encouraged to attend and bring guests to our Monday Night Bingos. Events are open to the public; we serve food and have a progressive jackpot. The cost is \$25.00 to attend, doors open at 5pm with games beginning at 6pm.

Last year we donated over \$28K to community youth organizations, which helped to offset their financial responsibilities; organizations such as the Glen Burnie High School Softball, BSA Troop 887, Old Mill High School Wrestling, Maryland Twisters Special Needs.

Post 40 now offers Free Rapid and PCR COVID-19 testing on Mondays and Fridays 1:00 - 5:00 pm and Tuesday - Thursday from 1:00 - 6:00 pm in the Hall. The first 30 minutes of each testing day is reserved for Legion members and their families, then testing will be open to the public. We ask that you wear your mask for testing and keep it on until you depart the testing site.

We have several events upcoming and I encourage you to participate. Cornhole will resume on Fridays in the hall when no bookings occur, SAL Valentines Dance is in February, American Legion Purse Bingo will be April 2nd, Shrimp Feast will be April 16th, Crab Feast September 10th, Annual Bull & Oyster Roast December 3rd. I encourage all our members to help us make 2022 the BEST year, so mark your calendars to support us and all our events in 2022. We will have several more events (Outback grand opening, First Responders Night) that will provide dates when they are confirmed. I also encourage all Legion members, as well as SAL & AUX, to volunteer for a Friday Night Dinner, Bingo, Legion events at least one time in 2022 so the volunteers who always step up can have a break this year. We are a Post, all members of the same Post, and need to be able to work together, depend on each other so we can do great things on behalf of Post 40. This past year I personally attended every Post 40 event and function and noticed the same ones volunteering, I challenge you as your Post commander to step up at least once this year to make our Post Great!

Please help us by not throwing your cigarette butts on the ground out-front of the lounge and please do not put trash in the butt cans. We have worked very hard this year to make Post 40 look better, by painting, cleaning, and organizing the Post and appreciate your help keeping it that way.
